BEWARE: "unofficial" St. Patrick's Day

New IN 2007: IF CAUGHT DISRUPTING CLASS, YOU FACE POSSIBLE DISMISS-

New in 2008: If convicted on a State ticket for underaged drinking, consumption or possession, you will lose your driver's license for a year. Even if you are given Court Supervision, you will lose it for 3 months!

New in 2009: If you receive a DUI ticket, you will have to install a breath alcohol interlock ignition device in your car OR wear an alcohol-monitoring ankle bracelet to get your license back at the end of the statutory suspension period or other suspension upon conviction.

Just a few Reminders for you:

Drinking until you see Leprechauns can get you a **disorderly conduct** charge and a **Public Intoxication** fine of \$300.00 <u>each</u>.

A **DUI** can get you a **loss of your license** for 1 year (2 years if <21) **jail time** up to 1 year, and a **fine** of \$2,500.00, AND see "New in 2009" above.

If you are <21 and are convicted of purchasing or possessing ANY amount of alcohol, your **driver's license will be suspended for 1 year**, in addition to a \$300.00 **fine**.

Using another Leprechaun's ID will cost you your **driver's license** (and the other person, too) and can result in **1 year in jail**.

University sanctions will be applied. Student Discipline will contact you.

There is NO pot of gold at the end of the rainbow for Leprechauns that are caught, just a LOT of debt and problems!
