### 1. Don't Rush In

- 1. There is no shortage of rental units in Champaign Urbana; the market has never been better for tenants to make choices.
- 2. Beware of unfinished buildings; they may or <u>may not</u> be ready for occupancy when the lease begins.
- 3. Roommates who commit too early to a lease may not follow through things change as time goes by.

## 2. Get It In Writing

- 1. The lease is the agreement between you and your landlord.
- 2. Promises made to you before you sign <u>must</u> be in the lease in order to be enforceable.
- 3. Review the lease carefully before signing it, on your own or with the Office of Community Life and Tenant Services (Tenant Union), 326 Illini Union.

- 3. See the actual house/apartment that you will be renting.
  - 1. Do not settle for seeing a "model" unit.
  - 2. Make a thorough inspection of the space you will be renting.

- 4. Choose roommates carefully.
  - 1. Do you really know this person?
  - 2. Is this person financially sound?
  - 3. Is this person likely to stay in school for the entire term of the lease?
  - 4. Does this person's lifestyle agree with yours?

### 5. Beware of discrimination.

- 1. It is illegal to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender, religion, handicap, sexual preference, familial status, welfare status or student status.
